Dear Dr. Trupnick:

Thank you so much for referring Mr. John Smith for a Colonoscopy. Please note this brief summary of my findings and recommendations, which are further detailed in the attached report.

Summary:

- Moderately severe diverticulosis (562.10) found in the sigmoid colon.
- A single large sessile polyp was found in the ileocecal valve (211.3); removed by hot biopsy polypectomy. Chromoscopy procedure performed.

Recommendations:

- Avoid all non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAID's) including but not limited to Ibuprofen, Advil, Motrin, and Nuprin for 5 days.
- Discharge home when standard parameters are met.
- Start high fiber diet.
- Colonoscopy recommended in 1 year. Patient to schedule a future appointment today.
- Follow-up on the results of the biopsy specimens in 1 week.
